The e-Science Institute is in the process of preparing its second Theme titled '*Exploiting Diverse Sources of Scientific Data*'.

This will involve organising a series of workshops and events around the above topic. Three events are already in the advanced stages of planning; the first is in November on [Spatiotemporal Databases for Geosciences, Biomedical sciences and Physical sciences](#) and is already open for registration. This will be followed by a meeting sponsored jointly with Oracle in which Chris Date will present a talk titled 'Temporal Database in Depth: Time and Data Warehouse.'

This theme is currently being led by Malcolm Atkinson, but we are seeking a long term visitor (a 'Theme Leader') who has the knowledge and interest to carry the development of this topic forward to its full capability.
